What is the purpose of IRELP?

Education and training opportunities in the renewable energy field are limited and concentrated in only a few industrialised countries with a comparatively well-developed renewable energy sector. However, even in these countries, the **demand for skilled personnel remains partly unsatisfied in the field of renewable energy**. IRELP aims to raise awareness on available renewable energy education and training opportunities, thereby enhancing their accessibility.

What is IRELP?

- A repertoire of education and training opportunities available worldwide;
- A library of renewable energy training materials;
- A database of webinars;
- An e-learning platform (Academy) where students receive support through e-learning lectures and tutorials;
- *A knowledge exchange corner (Forum) where professors, experts and training providers may benefit from invigorating dialogue, exchanging information, networking and developing curricula.*
